## EASTER SUNDAY 2024 – JESUS IS 'I AM '



Christ is risen... He is risen indeed, Hallelujah! Jesus risen from the grave is also the God of the Old Testament. Through every story of the Bible, he reveals himself to us because Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever. (Hebrews 13:8).

**Jesus our Creator:** In Genesis, God says 'Let us create mankind in our image' (Genesis 1:26). God the Father, the Son and the Holy

Spirit were there from the start.' Through the word (another name for Jesus), all things were made.'(1 John 1). Jesus was part of the miracle of our creation. He is the God who makes us 'fearfully and wonderfully' (Psalm 139:14). He is not only our creator, but he is our recreator as well. 'If anyone is in Christ he is a new creation.' (2 Corinthians 5:17).

Jesus our righteousness : After the fall of Adam and Eve, God provides his children with clothes to cover up their nakedness and shame. Through Jesus, God provides us with a greater covering. We are told to 'put on Christ' (Romans 13:14) and to 'Put on the full armour of God' (Ephesians 6:11). One piece of armour is the breastplate of righteousness. In Christ, we never have to hide from God or live in guilt and shame. We are given Jesus' righteousness to wear, in Christ we stand blameless before God. Jesus our Passover Lamb:

Throughout the Old Testament, we see God's people offering sacrifices to God. Sacrifices cleansed the people from their sins and made a way so that the priest could enter into God's presence. During the Passover, God tells the people to sacrifice a lamb and put its blood over their doorways, so that the angel of death will pass over. In Jesus, we see a 'new and living way' to enter God's presence (Hebrews 10:19). Jesus himself becomes the sacrifice once and for all. Now we can be cleansed from sin and forgiven, we can go into God's presence, death passes over us. All because of Jesus the lamb of God (John 1:29).

**Jesus our Freedom Bringer:** In Exodus, God sets his people free from slavery, he leads them through the waters of the red sea and into freedom. Jesus also leads us out of our slavery to sin and death. We go through the waters of baptism and are brought into new life and freedom in relationship with him.

**Jesus is 'I AM':** The 'I AM' that speaks to Moses is Jesus (John 8:58). In the gospel of John, Jesus tells us another 7 times that He is God. He says...

'I am the bread of life,' 'I am the light of the world,' 'I am the door of the sheep,' 'I am the good shepherd,' 'I am the way, the truth, and the life,' 'I am the true vine.' And perhaps the most important for today 'I am the resurrection and the life 11:25.'

Jesus is the only way to be recreated and brought into a right relationship with God. He is the one who brings forgiveness and freedom, he is the one who brings us from death to life. Turn to him this resurrection day and celebrate!
